**Prison Rape Elimination Act**  
**2019 PREA Coordinator's Annual Report**

This report has been prepared in accordance with §115.87 and §115.88 of the Prison Rape Elimination Act Standards, to address and improve the effectiveness of the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office and Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility in the prevention and detection of sexual abuse or harassment, and in setting response policies, practices, and training. In subsequent years, the information collected for this report will be used to identify problem areas and to take corrective action on an ongoing basis.

**Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA)**

The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) establishes a zero-tolerance standard against sexual abuse, sexual assault, or sexual harassment of incarcerated persons. It was signed on September 2003 by President George W. Bush. PREA is intended to address the detection, prevention, reduction, and prosecution of sexual harassment, sexual abuse, and sexual assault in correctional facilities throughout the United States. The Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) is a federal law that prohibits sexual abuse or misconduct in correctional settings such as prisons, jails, lockups, juvenile facilities and community confinement facilities.

The Sangamon County Sheriff's Office and Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility (SCSO) is committed to emphasizing zero-tolerance for sexual abuse, sexual harassment, or sexual assault of detainees/inmates, either by staff, vendors/contractors, visitors, or by other detainees/inmates. It shall be the policy of Sangamon County Sheriff's Office and Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility to provide a safe and secure environment for all detainees/inmates, employees, vendors/contractors, volunteers, and visitors, free from the threat of sexual abuse, sexual harassment, or sexual assault by effective policies and procedures designed for preventing, reporting, responding to, investigation, and tracking incidents or allegations of sexual abuse, harassment, or assault. All claims of sexual abuse or harassment will be investigated in a manner that avoids unnecessary embarrassment or indignity to the detainee/inmate. It shall also be the policy of the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office and Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility to pursue administrative, disciplinary, and/or criminal sanctions against any detainee/inmate, staff member, vendor/contractor, volunteer, or visitor found to have committed sexual abuse, sexual harassment, or sexual assault against a detainee/inmate. It shall be the responsibility of the health care staff to provide immediately first-aid to the victim and to refer the detainee/inmate to the appropriate medical facility.

**PREA Reporting**

**General Information**

During 2019, there were 8394 admissions to the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility. Of the new admissions, 5809 were male, 2579 were female, and 6 identified as transgender. The average daily population was 333, which includes 296 males and 37 females.

**PREA Reporting Activity**

The table below indicates the total number of Detainee/Inmate Against Detainee/Inmate and Staff Against Detainee/Inmate sexual abuse, sexual harassment, or sexual assault reports that occurred each year:

**PREA Reporting Definitions**

- Substantiated:** The incident was investigated and was determined to have occurred, based on a preponderance of evidence.
- Unsubstantiated:** The incident was investigated and was determined to have insufficient evidence to determine whether or not the incident occurred.
- Unfounded:** The incident was investigated and was determined NOT to have occurred.
- Non-PREA:** The investigation determined that the incident in question was not actually a PREA incident.
- Open:** The investigation has not concluded and is still considered active.
- Other:** The incident occurred at a facility other than, or prior to arrival at, the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office Adult Detention Facility.

In 2019, the Sangamon County Sheriff's investigated 27 PREA incidents. Of these incidents, 10 were Detainee/Inmate Against Detainee/Inmate; 8 were Staff Against Detainee/Inmate, 9 incidents were classified other than PREA, which included 4 Non-PREA incidents and 5 incidents that happened to subjects while out of custody.

Report findings for incident outcomes listed above are kept on file.

In March of 2018, the Sangamon County Sheriff's Office & Detention Facility passed a PREA Audit conducted by Correctional Consulting LLC with no correction action necessary. This PREA Audit Certification will remain in effect for three (3) years from the date of issue.
